

Community Guidelines

Last updated: June 10, 2026

Where2Vibe is built to help people discover real events, meet new people, support hosts, and find what is happening around them. These Community Guidelines explain what is and is not allowed on Where2Vibe.

By using Where2Vibe, you agree to follow these Guidelines, our Terms of Service, Privacy Policy, Ticket Purchase & Refund Policy, and any other rules we make available.

Where2Vibe is an 18+ platform. Many events may also be 21+ or have additional venue, ID, dress code, ticketing, or entry rules.

1. Our goal

Where2Vibe is for real events and real communities.

We want the app to help users find:

- parties;
- nightlife;
- clubs;
- raves;
- live music;
- comedy;
- car meets;
- happy hours;
- venue events;
- social events;
- other approved local experiences.

We want hosts to be able to promote events clearly, and we want users to feel like the app is useful, safe, and not full of fake or misleading posts.

2. Be real

Do not use Where2Vibe to mislead people.

You may not:

- create fake accounts;
- impersonate another person, host, venue, brand, artist, promoter, organization, or business;
- post fake events;
- post events you are not authorized to promote;
- use a venue name, flyer, logo, artist name, or brand without permission;
- lie about event details, prices, age limits, address, lineup, ticketing, or host identity;

- create duplicate events to manipulate visibility;
- pretend Where2Vibe is hosting or sponsoring your event unless we clearly agree in writing.

If your event is not real, not authorized, misleading, unsafe, or suspicious, we may remove it.

3. Host responsibly

Hosts are responsible for the events they post.

If you post or promote an event, you are responsible for:

- accurate date and time;
- accurate location or address-drop details;
- venue or property permission;
- legal compliance;
- age restrictions;
- ticket details;
- refund and cancellation updates;
- entry rules;
- safety rules;
- crowd expectations;
- capacity limits;
- flyer and image rights;
- permits, licenses, or approvals where required.

Do not post an event unless you have the right to promote it.

Do not sell tickets to an event you do not intend to host.

Do not use Where2Vibe to send users to unauthorized sign-up pages, phishing links, fake ticket pages, or third-party forms designed mainly to collect user information.

4. Car meet rules

Car meets are allowed when they are lawful, safe, and respectful.

Car meets on Where2Vibe should not promote or encourage:

- street takeovers;
- illegal racing;
- blocking roads or intersections;
- reckless driving;
- burnouts where illegal or unsafe;
- trespassing;
- damaging property;
- harassing businesses or residents;

- fleeing police;
- unsafe crowd behavior;
- weapons, violence, or threats.

If a car meet does not have permission to use a location, the host should be clear that users are responsible for following all property rules, local laws, and instructions from law enforcement, venue staff, or property owners.

Where2Vibe may remove car meet listings that appear likely to cause unsafe, illegal, or disruptive activity.

5. Party, nightlife, and venue rules

Parties, nightlife, clubs, raves, bars, and happy hours must follow all applicable laws and venue rules.

Do not post or promote events that encourage:

- underage drinking;
- illegal alcohol sales;
- illegal drug use or sales;
- weapons;
- violence;
- unsafe overcrowding;
- sexual exploitation;
- harassment;
- fake guest lists;
- fake covers;
- unauthorized venue use;
- misleading ticketing or entry promises.

If an event is 21+, has a dress code, requires ID, has limited capacity, or has special entry rules, hosts should make that clear.

Users are responsible for following venue rules, ID requirements, age restrictions, alcohol laws, and local laws.

6. No illegal activity

You may not use Where2Vibe to post, promote, organize, sell, request, or encourage illegal activity.

This includes:

- illegal drugs;
- weapons;
- stolen goods;
- counterfeit goods;
- counterfeit tickets;
- fake IDs;

- fraud;
- scams;
- trespassing;
- violence;
- threats;
- illegal racing;
- reckless driving;
- sex trafficking or exploitation;
- any other illegal conduct.

Where2Vibe may remove content, suspend accounts, ban users, restrict hosts, cancel tickets, hold payouts, or report activity to law enforcement when appropriate.

7. No harassment, threats, or hate

You may not harass, threaten, intimidate, bully, stalk, dox, or target others.

You may not post or send content that attacks, degrades, or excludes people based on:

- race;
- ethnicity;
- national origin;
- religion;
- gender;
- gender identity;
- sexual orientation;
- disability;
- medical condition;
- age;
- veteran status;
- or any other protected status.

This applies to events, profiles, messages, group chats, comments, reports, flyers, and any other content on Where2Vibe.

8. No sexual exploitation or unsafe sexual content

Where2Vibe is not for sexual exploitation, nudity, prostitution, escort services, sex trafficking, sexual harassment, or content sexualizing minors.

You may not post:

- nudity or explicit sexual content;
- sexual services;

- sexual solicitation;
- non-consensual sexual content;
- content involving minors in a sexual way;
- sexually threatening or harassing messages;
- event listings that appear to promote exploitation.

We may remove content and accounts immediately for violations.

9. No spam, scams, or platform abuse

Do not use Where2Vibe to spam users or abuse the platform.

You may not:

- send repeated unwanted messages;
- post fake links;
- promote scams;
- phish for login or payment information;
- spread malware;
- manipulate event rankings;
- abuse referrals or promoter codes;
- create fake accounts;
- use bots or automation;
- mass-post duplicate events;
- bypass moderation;
- evade bans;
- use the app to collect user data outside the Service.

Promoter, referral, and reward abuse may result in lost rewards, canceled commissions, account restrictions, payout holds, or bans.

10. No ticket fraud

Do not use Where2Vibe to commit ticket fraud.

You may not:

- sell fake tickets;
- duplicate tickets;
- resell tickets without permission;
- use refunded tickets;
- use voided or disputed tickets;
- share QR codes or backup codes for fraud;
- attempt to enter with a copied ticket;

- file false refund claims;
- abuse chargebacks;
- use stolen payment methods.

Invalid, refunded, duplicated, disputed, already scanned, or fraudulent tickets may be rejected.

11. Respect privacy

Do not share someone else's private information without permission.

This includes:

- phone numbers;
- addresses;
- exact personal location;
- private messages;
- personal photos;
- IDs;
- payment information;
- screenshots meant to harass or expose someone;
- private social media information.

Do not use Where2Vibe to dox, stalk, track, or harass people.

12. Group and messaging rules

Group chats and messages should be used for event planning, community discussion, and respectful interaction.

Do not use groups or messages for:

- harassment;
- threats;
- hate speech;
- sexual harassment;
- spam;
- scams;
- illegal activity;
- doxxing;
- unwanted promotion;
- fake ticket sales;
- drug or weapon sales;
- repeated unwanted contact.

Group owners may remove members or delete groups where available. Users can leave groups or block users where available.

Reported messages may be reviewed by Where2Vibe.

13. Flyers, photos, logos, and copyrighted content

Only upload content you have the right to use.

Do not upload flyers, logos, photos, videos, artist names, venue names, brand names, or other content in a way that infringes someone else's rights or misleads users.

If you use a venue, artist, promoter, DJ, brand, or organization name, you must not falsely suggest that they are hosting, sponsoring, or approving the event.

Where2Vibe may remove content that appears to infringe rights, impersonate someone, mislead users, or violate our rules.

14. 18+ app rule and age-restricted events

Where2Vibe is for users who are at least 18 years old.

Some events may be 21+ or have other age restrictions. Users are responsible for knowing whether they are legally allowed to attend.

Hosts should clearly list age restrictions when they know them.

Venues, hosts, security, or event staff may require ID and may deny entry if a user does not meet age or ID requirements.

Where2Vibe does not guarantee that every user, attendee, or host is the age they claim to be.

15. Safety at events

Use common sense before attending an event.

Before going, consider:

- whether the event seems real;
- whether the host seems trustworthy;
- whether the location makes sense;
- whether the event has clear details;
- whether you know how you are getting there and back;
- whether the event has age, ticket, or entry requirements;
- whether you feel safe attending.

Do not drink and drive. Do not ride with unsafe drivers. Do not bring weapons. Do not participate in violence, illegal racing, takeovers, trespassing, or unsafe behavior.

Where2Vibe is not an emergency service. If there is immediate danger, contact local emergency services, venue staff, security, or the event organizer.

16. Reporting

If you see something that violates these Guidelines, report it.

You can report:

- events;
- profiles;
- messages;
- groups;
- fake hosts;
- unsafe events;
- harassment;
- scams;
- ticket fraud;
- illegal activity;
- underage or age-restricted concerns;
- copyright or impersonation issues.

Use the Report button in the app or email: support@where2vibe.com

Include screenshots, event names, usernames, links, and details when possible.

We aim to review reports within 24 hours. Urgent safety concerns should include URGENT in the email subject.

17. Blocking users

You can block users where the app provides blocking tools.

Blocked users cannot message you or interact with your content through blocked features.

Blocking is useful if someone is bothering you, but serious threats, scams, harassment, or safety issues should also be reported.

18. What happens when rules are broken

Where2Vibe may take action when we believe these Guidelines, our Terms, or our policies have been violated.

Actions may include:

- removing content;
- hiding events;
- rejecting events;
- requiring edits;
- warning users;
- limiting features;
- removing messages;
- removing group access;
- restricting host tools;

- restricting ticketing;
- holding payouts;
- canceling promotions;
- removing promoter rewards;
- invalidating tickets;
- suspending accounts;
- banning accounts;
- contacting law enforcement where appropriate.

Severe or repeated violations may result in permanent removal from Where2Vibe.

19. Appeals

If you believe your content or account was removed, restricted, or suspended by mistake, you may contact: support@where2vibe.com

Include:

- your account email;
- the event or content involved;
- what happened;
- why you believe the action was incorrect;
- any supporting information.

Where2Vibe may review appeals, but we are not required to restore content, accounts, tickets, payouts, promotions, or access.

20. Final note

Where2Vibe works best when users post real events, respect each other, follow the law, and use good judgment.

We want the app to help people find what is happening around them without turning into spam, scams, fake events, unsafe meets, or harassment.
